I am pleased to report your credit union greatly exceeded expectations in 2017. For members, our exceptional growth provides a resource to deliver on our mission of: **Helping Make Your**

Dreams Come True. Living this mission provides retirees a safe haven to protect their savings, a new home for a growing family and a young driver their first set of keys. These simple acts of people-helping-people provide gratifying work for your volunteer board and credit union staff.

The following key performance areas demonstrate the progress of Winnebago Community Credit Union in 2017:

- Loan growth was outstanding, loans to members increased 14.5% to \$85.6 Million.
- Our delinquent loan rate was .21%, far below our credit union peers.
- Assets grew 5.7% to \$97.8 Million.
- Membership increased by 3.6%, ending the year with 7,455 members.
- Member Equity, used to protect the credit union, rose to over \$11 Million.

Community Involvement Highlights:

- Our WCCU Moms program published 45 educational features to help member families make better financial decisions.
- Sponsorship of Winnebago County Park System 50th Birthday.
- Pollock Waterpark sponsorship of the summer special event series.



63rd Annual Meeting Minutes

The 63rd Annual Meeting was called to order by Chairman Geske on March 2nd, 2017 at 6:03 p.m. at the Elks Club, Oshkosh. Secretary Schug certified that a quorum of greater than 15 voting members were present. Present at the meeting were 94 members, nine joint members and five guests.

Chairman Geske presented the Chairman's report. He then invited comments, corrections or additions for the Chairman's, Treasurer's, Credit Committee's and last year's annual meeting minutes.

Chairman Geske presented the two nominees for election to fill two vacancies; Kimberly Schug and John Sheehan. The call from the floor for additional nominations was issued three times. Hearing no response from the membership, Chairman Geske closed nominations. Chairman Geske entertained a motion directing Secretary Schug to cast one unanimous vote to elect the two nominees as Directors of Winnebago Community Credit Union. Motion made by member Susan Berg and unanimously carried.

Secretary Schug stated there was no old business. Chairman Geske adjourned the meeting at 6:18 p.m. on a motion by Mitchel Gebheim and unanimously carried.
